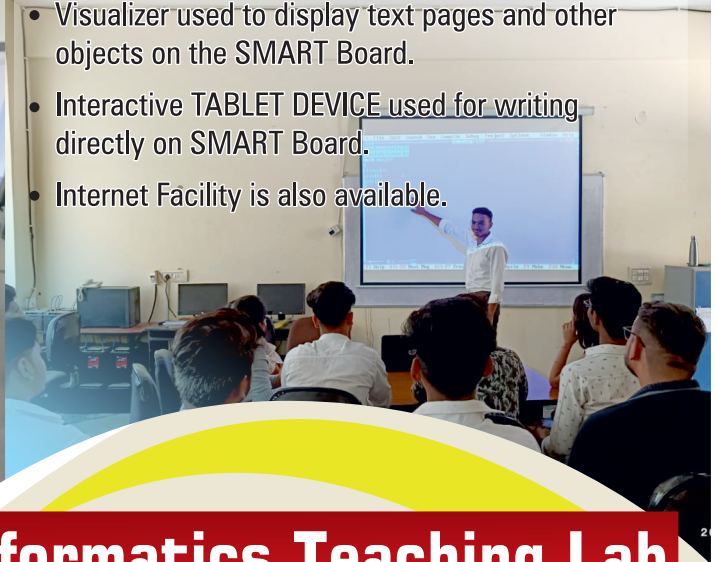
## TRANSPORT FACILITIES

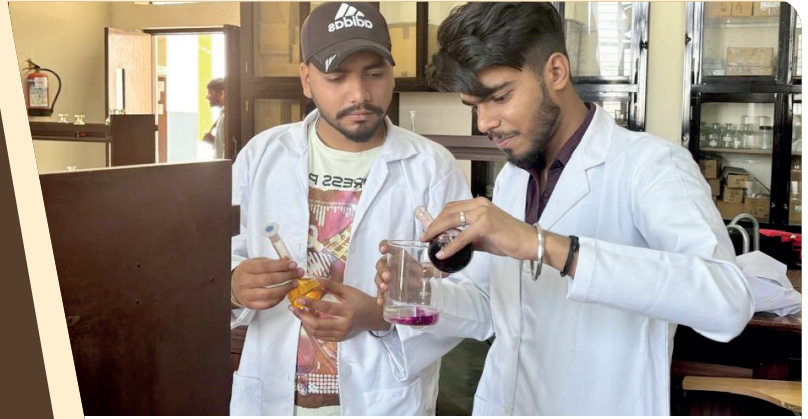
## Chemistry Lab

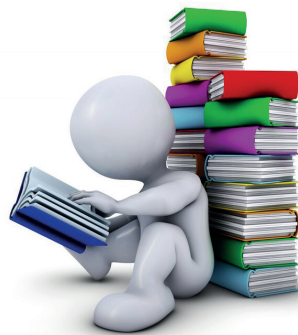

newspapers like The Hindu, The Times of India, The Economic Times, The Indian Express, The Tribune and Punjab Kesari are also available.

- A good collection of books to help students to prepare for various competitive examinations such as NET, Bank exams, IAS, PCS, Chartered Accountancy, NDA, CDS, SSC etc. are available. New stock of latest books are added annually as per the need of students.



# LIBRARY RULES



The college has a well-equipped computerized library. It is well stocked with books, journals, magazines and daily newspapers. The students are encouraged to make the best use of the library. The library remains open during the working hours of the college i.e. 9:00 am to 4:00 pm.

1. Identity card is compulsory while visiting the library.
2. A student can get the book issued for a maximum period of 14 days.
3. The same book can be re-issued with the consent of the librarian if not in demand.
4. The Librarian can ask a student to return the book before the expiry of time in case of urgency.
5. The students will be fined Rs.2/- per day if they fail to return the books on time. And even after one week, if they fail to return the issued book, then he/she will be fined Rs. 5/- per day. If a student is found defaulter continuously, the librarian with the approval of Principal, can debar him/her from using the library.
6. It is the duty of the students to keep the books in proper place. They should verify the conditions of the books while getting them issued from the library. They should report about the bad shape or torn pages to the librarian immediately. If they fail to do so, they will be held responsible for the damage and will have to pay the full price of the book. If the damaged book is a part of a series of books, she/he will have to pay the full price of the whole set. The price will be charged as per the latest price of the edition.
7. No student is to underline or tear the pages from the books.
8. The books issued to the students must be used for their personal use only.
9. The students are advised to maintain complete silence in the library.
10. While returning the books, the students are advised to get the same struck off from the Identity Card.



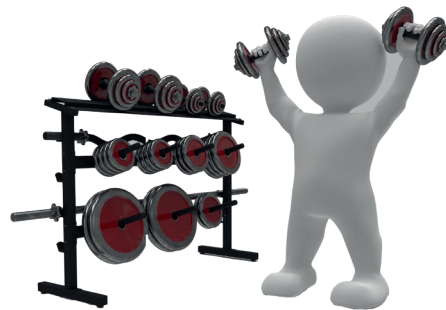
11. All payments, including fines regarding the library shall be paid in the college offices and receipt is to be shown to the librarian.
12. Periodicals, newspapers and technical reports are not issued out of the library to anybody.
13. No transfer certificate or any other certificate shall be issued to a student until the books have been returned and dues outstanding against the student discharged.
14. In case any borrowed item being lost, damaged or destroyed, you are required to replace them.
15. Practice Good Manners! Any kind of food item is not allowed in the library. Only water bottles are permitted in the reading room.
16. Private conversations, chatting, talking and standing may disturb others.
17. Students should take care of the cleanliness of the library.
18. Students should not disturb the arrangement of the library furniture, library resources, facilities etc.

### BACHELOR OF ARTS



#### **Eligibility:**

Senior Secondary Examination (10+2) of Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani with 40% marks in aggregate.

OR

Any other examination recognized by the University as equivalent.

*Note: Minimum passing marks in case of SC/ST candidates of Haryana.*

#### **Compulsory Subjects:**

##### **English, Hindi**

*Note: Environmental studies and computer literacy are the compulsory papers which the candidates are required to pass with at least 33% marks in the 1<sup>st</sup> year of the Course. In case of failure in these two exams, the degree will not be awarded.*

#### **Elective Subjects-Choose any two:**

History, Political Science, Geography, Economics, Maths, Sanskrit, Home Science, Physical Education.

### Bachelor of Commerce

#### **Eligibility:**

Senior Secondary Examination (10+2) of Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani with 40% marks in aggregate.

OR

Any other examination recognized by the University as equivalent.

*Note: Minimum passing marks in case of SC/ST candidates of Haryana.*

*Environment studies is the compulsory paper which the candidates are required to pass with at least 40% marks in the 1<sup>st</sup> year of the Course, failing which the degree will not be issued.*

*Note:- Curriculum as per university rule*



## **BACHELORS OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION**

### **Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) Eligibility:**

Senior Secondary Examination (10+2) of Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani with 45% marks in aggregate or an equivalent examination recognised by this University.

OR

Three years Management Course conducted by State Board of Technical Education or any other examination recognized by the State Board of Technical Education as equivalent thereto.

*Environment studies is the compulsory paper which the candidates are required to pass with at least 40% marks in the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of the Course. In case of failure in this subject, the degree will not be issued.*

**Note:- Curriculum as per university rule**

## **BACHELOR OF COMPUTER APPLICATIONS**

### **Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA) Eligibility:**

Senior Secondary Examination (10+2) of Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani with 45% marks in aggregate or an equivalent examination recognised by this University.

OR

Three years Management Course conducted by State Board of Technical Education or any other examination recognized by the State Board of Technical Education as equivalent thereto.

*Environment studies is the compulsory paper which the candidates are required to pass with at least 40% marks in the 1<sup>st</sup> year of the Course. In case of failure in this subject, the degree will not be issued.*

**Note:- Curriculum as per university rule**

## **B.Sc. (Non-Medical)**

### **Eligibility:**

Senior Secondary Examination (10+2) of Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani with 40% marks in aggregate.

OR

Any other examination recognized by the University as equivalent.

**Note:** Minimum passing marks in case of SC/ST candidates of Haryana.

*Environment studies is the compulsory paper which the candidates are required to pass with at least 40% marks in the 1<sup>st</sup> year of the Course. In case of failure in this subject, the degree will not be issued.*

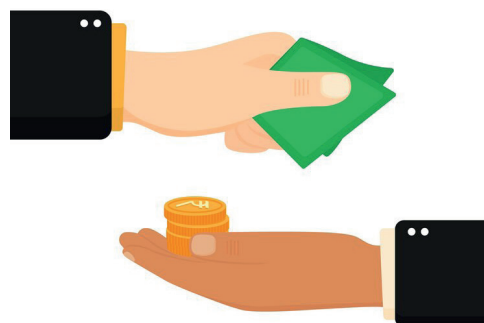

**The transportation fee is required to be paid quartely (on a 3 months basis)**

Students in the SC and Other (including General, BC, and ST) categories must pay a token fee of 3000 and 5,000, respectively, at the time of admission.

After admission, students must pay 50% of the course fee within one month.

## RULES

- It is compulsory for all students to pay at least 25% of the course fee in first instalment.
- Special concession will be offered to the students who pay their complete fee in a single instalment. The concession will become slightly less for those who pay it in two instalments.
- There will be 40% discount on each course fee for **SC** and **ST** students.

**Note:** If the fee is not paid by the due dates, fine will be charged. And, in case, the fee is not cleared in 15 days after the due dates, the students will not be allowed to take examinations.

# GENERAL RULES



Maintenance of strict discipline on the campus during the study hours is our main concern.

1. The students must read the Notice-Board daily for getting day-to-day information.
2. The last entry time in the morning is 10:30 a.m. Students will not be permitted to leave the college before 1:00 p.m. without the permission of the Principal/Teacher.
3. In case of an emergency, if a student wants to leave before 1:00 pm, he/she must get gate pass with the sign of class teacher and Principal.
4. The students are not allowed to receive letters and couriers at the college address.
5. The students are not allowed to receive guests at the college campus.
6. The attendance of every student is compulsory during every function of the college. Absentees will be fined.
7. The student should immediately report the change of address and phone no. to the college office.
8. College property should be handled with great care. Scribbling and dirtying the walls or any place in any way is strictly prohibited. Loss or destruction of college property is chargeable individually i.e. college books, furniture, fans, laboratory experiments, computers and gadgets etc. No furniture or other stuff should be replaced.
9. Students shall not resort any strikes, dharna or conduct any procession within the campus.
10. Students are directed to park their vehicles only in the area allotted for them.
11. The Principal's decision in all matters relating to admission, administration and enforcement or discipline and general rules and special instructions mentioned in this prospectus shall be final & binding on all.
12. Without prior sanction of the Principal, students are not permitted:
  - (a) to convene or attend meetings of any sort in any circumstances anywhere in the college buildings or its premises.
  - (b) to set up entertainments or organize social functions in the college.
  - (c) to make use of megaphones and loudspeakers in the campus.
  - (d) to invite any outsiders to the college for any functions.
  - (e) to collect subscriptions of any kind.
  - (f) to put up notices or hoist flags of any organisation or to display banners, posters, bunting etc. anywhere in the campus.
  - (g) to place any paper, periodical or book in the reading room or circulate them in the college.

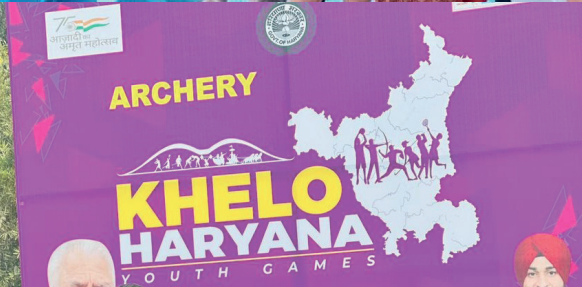

# ACADEMIC RULES AND RELATED INFORMATION



## Attendance Rules

No student shall be deemed to have pursued a regular course of study unless he/she has attended at least 65% of the lectures in each semester/year in semester system/annual system and also in practical training.

## Discipline at Campus

Any act of misconduct committed by a student inside or outside the campus shall be an act of violation of discipline of the college. Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing provision, violation of the discipline shall include:

- Disruption of teaching, study, examination, research or administrative work, curricular or extra-curricular activity or residential life of the members of the college, including any attempt to prevent any member of the college or its staff from carrying on his or her work and doing any act reasonably likely to cause such disruption.
- Damaging or defacing college property or the property of the members of the college or any other property inside or outside the college campus.
- Engaging in any attempt as wrongful confinement of teachers, officers, employees and students of the college or camping inside or creating nuisance inside the boundaries of houses of teachers, officers and other members of the college.



- Use of abusive and derogatory slogans or intimidatory language or incitement of hatred and violence or any act calculated to further the same.
- Eve-teasing or disrespectful behaviour to women or girl students.
- Any assault upon or intimidation of or insulting behaviour towards a teacher, officer, employee or student or any other person.
- Causing or colluding in the unauthorised entry of any person in the campus or in the unauthorised occupation of any portion of college premises.
- Getting enrolled in more than one course of study simultaneously in violation of University rules.
- Committing forgery, tampering with or misuse of college documents or records, identification cards etc..
- Furnishing false certificate or false information to any office under the control and jurisdiction of the college.
- Consuming or possessing alcoholic drinks, dangerous drugs or other intoxicants in the college premises.



- Possessing or using weapons such as knives, lathis, iron chains, iron rods, sticks, explosives and fire arms in the college premises.
- Arousing communal, caste or regional feelings or creating disharmony among students.
- Not disclosing one's identity when asked to do so by an employee or officer of the college who is authorized to ask for identity.
- Any offence under law.
- Committing any of the offences specified in the examination (Control of unfair means and disorderly conduct) of the college.
- Pasting of posters or distributing pamphlets, handbills etc. of objectionable nature or writing on walls and disfiguring building.



# APPLICATION PROCEDURE



As an affiliated college of MD university, admission to Guru Nanak Institute of Higher Education is as outlined in MDU Bulletin of Information for Admission to Undergraduate Courses.

Applicants seeking admission to Undergraduate Courses are required to fill the Online Admission Form on the HIGHER EDUCATION Admission Portal ([admission.highereduhry.com/web/index.php/registration](http://admission.highereduhry.com/web/index.php/registration))

Applicants who wish to be considered for admission to various Undergraduate Courses based on merit (for which there is no entrance exam) are required to register online for all categories, including unreserved (UR) / SC / ST / OBC.

The applicants who wish to apply under supernumerary categories, namely Reservation of seats for Persons with Disabilities (PwD), Kashmiri Migrant (KM), Reservation for Armed Forces (CW) and Ward Quota shall also apply online on the HIGHER EDUCATION admission portal.

The registration of applicants seeking admission under Sports/Extra-curricular activities (ECA) categories is through the same HIGHER EDUCATION admission portal.

University reserves the right to revise, amend, update, or delete any part of this bulletin without giving any prior notice. Any change so made shall be updated on the HIGHER EDUCATION Admission Portal.

Applicants are responsible for regularly checking the portal for any updates.

Applicants are encouraged to visit the college website [www.gnihe.ac.in](http://www.gnihe.ac.in) to obtain an overview of the college and details of the selection criteria which would form the basis of admission.

60% fees will be charged for SC/ST Students.

Scholarship will be offered to those applicants who have played any sport at district level, state level as well as national level.



# GENERAL INFORMATION



1. A student of Sem-I may be permitted to change his/her subject(s) within one month from the commencement of session.
2. A student of B.A./B.Sc Year-II (Sem-III) may be allowed to change only one subject within one month from the commencement of the session.
  - i) Change to a subject involving practicals will not be allowed.
  - ii) The candidates will be treated as reappear in changed subject of Year-I (Sem-I & II) and he/she will be required to clear the same within the permissible chances as available to other students having compartment in Year-I (Sem-I & II).
3. No fee concession for students (General/SC/ST/OBC) who do not fulfill the attendance criteria of 75%.
4. Every details regarding your assignments, test, practical will be announced by the respective teacher in the classroom and will also be sent by email/whatsapp to the students. Assignment, test & mid-term examination are compulsory for the students.
5. Parents-teachers meet shall be organised at the mid of the session which is compulsory for all to attend.
6. A candidate, who after seeking admission in a course, left that course in between and seeks admission in other course may be allowed to continue the said course if he/she is able to complete the said course within the maximum period prescribed for completing a course which is the duration of the course + 4 years, unless otherwise specified in any other ordinance.
7. If a candidate after having been admitted to the first year of a course, leaves the course without attending any class and he/she applies for refund of fee within 7 days of the date of admission, the fee paid by her/him shall be refunded after deducting Rs. 1000/-.

If a candidate after having admitted to the first year of a course withdraws his/her candidature after 7 days and the seat vacated by him/her is subsequently filled up from the waiting list, the fee paid by him/her be refunded after deducting 25% of the total fee of one year by him/her subject to a minimum of Rs. 1000/-.

In a similar case if the seat vacated by a candidate is not filled up, the fee paid by him/her would not be refunded.

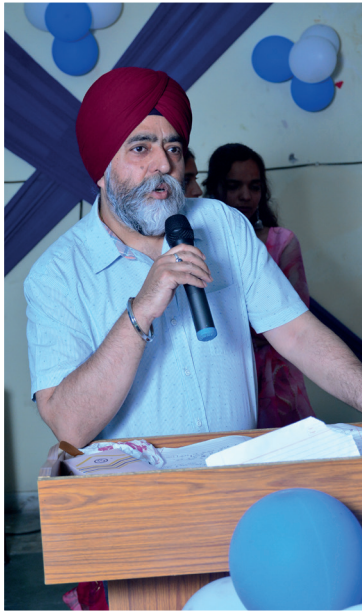

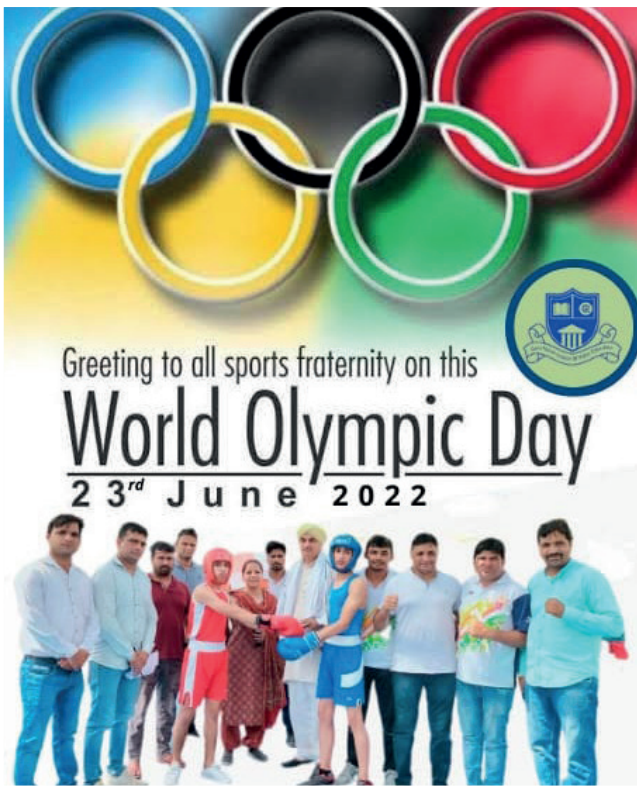
